County to Renovate Hoffstadt Bluffs Visitor Center

Twelve years after opening Hoffstadt Bluffs Visitor Center, Cowlitz County has temporarily closed the facility and has begun a long overdue renovation of the post and beam structure. Located at Milepost 27 on Highway 504, the 19,000 square foot facility will reopen in the Spring of 2009.

The renovations to the first and second floors will include a new restaurant layout, remodeled gift shop, and updated meeting space. New flooring and displays will be placed throughout the building.

“We are looking forward to the challenges at Hoffstadt Bluffs and once again becoming a good neighbor on the highway,” said Mike Moss, Director. “It’s our goal to make Hoffstadt Bluffs Visitor Center a destination which will benefit all of Highway 504.”
