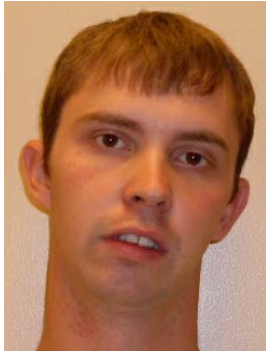

Child Molest 1st (2cts); Comm Minor for Immoral Purposes



According to official documents on 11/20/01, Evan Howard Brown was found guilty in Cowlitz County Superior Court Juvenile Division of (2) Counts of Child Molestation in the 1st Degree. Mr. Brown 15yo admitted to having played with his 6 and 7 year old nephews and to having them perform oral sex on each other as well as touch each other. On 04/13/06 Mr. Brown was convicted in Cowlitz County Superior Court of Communicating with a Minor for Immoral Purposes (Felony). Mr. Brown had consensual intercourse with a 13yo victim according to the police report. Mr. Brown had been given a SSODA which was revoked. Mr. Brown also self disclosed two additional victims, one female and one male. There were no charges filed.

The Cowlitz County Sheriff's Office is releasing this information pursuant to RCW 4.24.550 and the Washington State Supreme Court decision State v. Ward, which authorizes law enforcement agencies to inform the public of a sex offender release when, at the discretion of the Agency and the Risk Assessment Committee, the information will enhance public safety and protection. The sex offender listed has served the sentence imposed by the courts and has advised the Cowlitz County Sheriff's Office of their address. This Registered Offender is not wanted at this time. This notification is not intended to increase fear; rather it is our belief that an informed public is a safer public. Law enforcement agencies have no legal authority to direct where a sex offender may or may not live. Unless court ordered restrictions exist, this offender is constitutionally free to live anywhere. Citizen abuse of this information to threaten or harass registered sex offenders will not be tolerated. Such abuse could potentially end law enforcement's ability to do community notifications. The Cowlitz County Sheriff's Office can provide useful information on personal safety. SOME SUGGESTIONS FOR SELF-PROTECTION:

1. You and your children should be continually aware of who is around you. If they are unfamiliar to you, don't put yourself in jeopardy.
2. Be aware of where your children are. Try to establish a time share child watching effort for children playing in the neighborhood.
3. Establish neighborhood safe havens for children as well as adults.
4. Urge your children to play in the area of other children, and caution them to not go anywhere with strangers.
5. Plan methods of escape, routes of escape and methods of self protection
