According to official documents on 02/28/01 John Anson Hanna Jr. in Clark County Superior Court pled guilty to Child Molestation in the 2nd Degree and Felony Communicative with a Minor for Immoral Purposes. Mr. Hanna 45yo had sexual contact with a 13yo familial female. He fondled her breasts, buttocks, and digitally penetrated her vagina. On the communicating charge Mr. Hanna, naked, made explicit sexual remarks to the 13 familial female victim and the 11yo non-familial female victim. In 1994 Mr. Hanna was charged with Child Molestation 1st degree where the 13 yo above mentioned victim had been sexually assaulted when she was 2 to 3 yo. The charges were dismissed without prejudice. In 1991 Mr. Hanna was convicted of (2) Cts Child Molestation in the 1st Degree in Clark County. Mr. Hanna sexually assaulted a 7yo known female by fondling and digitally penetrating the victim's vagina. While incarcerated Mr. Hanna completed about 11 months of Sex Offender Treatment.

The Longview Police Department is releasing this information pursuant to RCW 4.24.550 and the Washington State Supreme Court decision State v. Ward, which authorizes law enforcement agencies to inform the public of a sex offender release when, at the discretion of the Agency and the Risk Assessment Committee, the information will enhance public safety and protection. The sex offender listed has served the sentence imposed by the courts and has advised the Longview Police Dept. and the Cowlitz County Sheriff's Office of their address. This Registered Offender is not wanted at this time. This notification is not intended to increase fear; rather it is our belief that an informed public is a safer public. Law enforcement agencies have no legal authority to direct where a sex offender may or may not live. Unless court ordered restrictions exist, this offender is constitutionally free to live anywhere. Citizen abuse of this information to threaten or harass registered sex offenders will not be tolerated. Such abuse could potentially end law enforcement's ability to do community notifications. The Longview Police Dept. can provide useful information on personal safety. SOME SUGGESTIONS FOR SELF-PROTECTION:

1. You and your children should be continually aware of who is around you. If they are unfamiliar to you, don't put yourself in jeopardy.
2. Be aware of where your children are. Try to establish a time share child watching effort for children playing in the neighborhood.
3. Establish neighborhood safe havens for children as well as adults.
4. Urge your children to play in the area of other children, and caution them to not go anywhere with strangers.
5. Plan methods of escape, routes of escape and methods of self protection
